## Frithdhúnadh Bhaile Átha Cliath 1913

B'uafásach dálaí maireachtála na mbochtán i mBaile Átha Cliath i 1913. Bhí pá na n-oibrithe neamhoilte fíor-íseal agus bhí cónaí ar na hoibrithe sin i dtionóntáin phlódaíthe áit a raibh galar forleathan agus ráta báis ard. D'eagraigh James Larkin, bunaitheoir agus ceannaire Cheardchumann Iompair agus Ilsaothair na hÉireann, sraith stailceanna a bhain le carraeirí, dugairí, fir iamróid agus oibrithe tram chun a bpá agus a ndálaí maireachtála a fheabhsú.

As seo, d'eascair coimhlínt bhineach le Cónaidhm Fhostóirí Bhaile Átha Cliath a d'imir frithdhúnadh ar a gcuid oibrithe. Thacaigh cearchumainn eile lena gcomhoibrithe, rud ba chionsiocair le corraí agus dífhostaíocht bhreise. Bhí an t-achrann seo ar cheann de na hachrainn ba mhó agus ba thábhachtaí i stair saothair na hÉireann. Mhair sé ón 26 Lúnasa 1913 go dtí an 18 Eanáir 1914 agus bhí os cionn 20,000 oibrí agus 400 fostóir páirteach ann. Réitigh sé an bealach do théarmaí fostaíochta níos cothroime d'oibrithe na hÉireann.

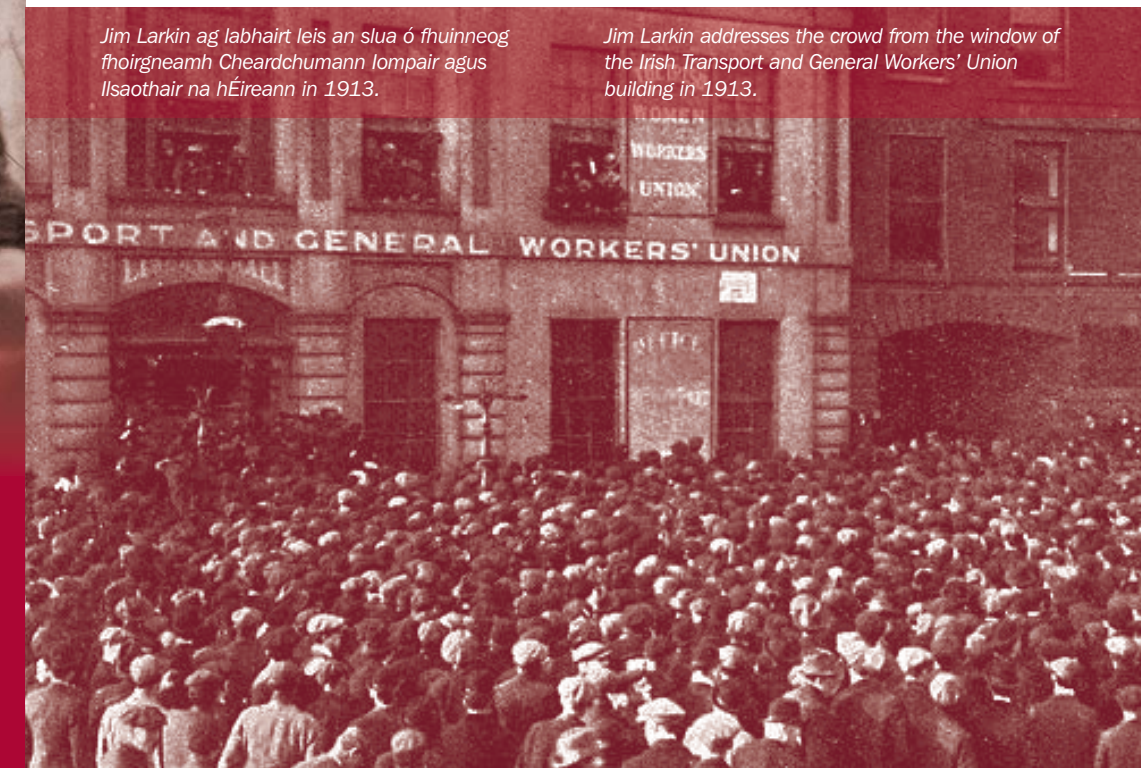
## The 1913 Dublin Lockout

In 1913, the living conditions of the poor in Dublin were dire. Unskilled workers were badly paid and lived in over-crowded tenements where disease was rife and mortality rates high. James Larkin, founder and leader of the Irish Transport and General Workers' Union, organised a series of strikes involving carters, dockers, railwaymen and tram workers to improve their pay and working conditions.

A bitter conflict ensued with the Dublin Employers' Federation who locked out their workers. Other unions supported their fellow workers leading to further unrest and unemployment. The dispute was one of the largest and most important in Irish labour history. It lasted from 26 August 1913 to 18 January 1914 and involved over 20,000 workers and 400 employers. It paved the way for fairer employment for Irish workers.

I gcomhar leis an Roinn Airgeadais, tá líon teoranta de bhoinn inbhailithe á eisiúint ag Banc Ceannais na hÉireann chun cothrom céad bliain Fhrithdhúnadh Bhaile Átha Cliath 1913 a chomóradh.

Rinneadh na boinn inbhailithe stairiúla €15 seo a bhualadh chuig an gcaighdeán is airde profa. Ar chúl an bhoinn, taispeántar léiriú siombalach de Jim Larkin agus é ag labhairt le slua oibríthe ar dúnadh na geataí rompu agus lena gcuid teaghlach. Ba é an dealbhóir clúiteach, Rory Breslin, a dhear.

Ar aghaidh an bhoinn, tá an léiriú traidisiúnta den chruit Ghaelach.

In conjunction with the Department of Finance, the Central Bank of Ireland is issuing a limited edition collector coin to commemorate the Centenary of The 1913 Dublin Lockout.

These historic limited issue €15 collector coins have been struck to the highest proof quality. The reverse of the coin features a symbolic representation of Jim Larkin addressing a gathering of locked-out workers and their families. The design is by renowned Irish sculptor Rory Breslin.

The obverse of the coin bears the traditional representation of the Irish harp.

## Eisiúint Theoranta de Bhonn Profa Airgid €15

Tá múnú na mboinn inbhailithe stairiúil €15 seo fíorghalánta agus is ómós feiliúnach iad don chomóradh céad bliain suntasach seo i stair na hÉireann. Rinneadh gach bonn a bhualadh chuig caighdeán profa .925 airgid steirling agus is i mbosca galánta taispeántais a bheidh gach bonn. Beidh Deimhniú Údarachta uimhríthe, ina ndeimhneofar an teorainn eisiúna íseal, ag gabháil le gach ceann díobh freisin.

Tá teorainn dhocht arb ionann agus 10,000 bonn airgid ag gabháil le heisiúint an bhoinn chomórtha seo. Tá spéis mhór á léiriú cheana féin ag bailitheoirí in Éirinn agus ag bailitheoirí ar fud an domhain sna boinn seo. Táthar ag súil go mbeidh an-éileamh orthu. Má theastaíonn uait ceann a fháil, ná déan moill.

Seolfar na boinn an 24 Meán Fómhair 2013 agus déanfar na horduithe a sheachadadh go luath ina dhiaidh sin.

## An Dearthóir - Rory Breslin

Rinne Rory Breslin staidéar ar an ealaín sa Choláiste Náisiúnta Ealaíne is Deartha agus i Sasana, sa Fhrainc, i bPoblacht na Seice agus sa tSlóvaic. Bhí sé ina chomhbhunaitheoir ar Dhánlann Dealbhóireachta na gCeann i mBaile Átha Cliath agus bhíodh sé ag léachtóireacht go páirtaimseartha sa Choláiste Náisiúnta Ealaíne is Deartha agus tá neart taispeántas dá shaothar líniúchta agus dealbhóireachta curtha ar bun aige in Éirinn agus thar lear. Faoi láthair, tá cónaí air in Iarthar na hÉireann.

“Léirítear na sluaite i gcúlra an deartha; tá fir ann a bhfuil caipíní boga píce orthu agus mná a bhfuil hataí orthu. Tá sé tábhachtach go mbeadh mná san íomhá mar cé gurb iad na fir a taispeánadh go príomha ar na sráideanna ag cruinnithe i bpictiúir ón am sin, bhí tionchar ollmhór ag an teagmhas seo ar theaghlach.

Ar an mbonn, léirítear barraí geata agus glas agus feictear an slua agus Larkin sa chúla. Leis na barraí sin, dealraítear don bhreathnóir go bhfuil sé nó sí ag breathnú trí na barraí, móitíf a dhéanann deighilt idir an radharc sin agus muidne atá san am i láthair agus a bhfuil iliomad ceart againn arna ngnóthú le dua mór, ní hamháin i ndlí an tsaothair ach i mBunreacht na hÉireann agus sa dlí Eorpach chomh maith. Ní hamháin go leagtar béim ar sheasamh cruca na bhfostóirí ag an am sin leis an íomhá den ghlas sin ach, ina theannta sin, is tagairt phictiúrtha é don chomóradh céad bliain agus don ainm comónta, Frithdhúnadh Bhaile Átha Cliath.

Trí dhul ar chúl Larkin sa phictiúr, bímid ar aghaidh an tslua, slua atá déanta suas de dhaoine éagsúla a bhfuil a scéal féin ag gach duine díobh. Ar an gcaoi sin, aistrítear an bhéim ó Larkin mar phointe fócasach den phictiúr go dtí an pobal agus a gruachás ag an am.”

## The Designer - Rory Breslin

Rory Breslin studied art at the National College of Art and Design as well as in England, France, Czech Republic and Slovakia. He co-founded the Head Sculpture gallery in Dublin, has lectured part-time in the National College of Art and Design and has had numerous solo drawing and sculpture exhibitions in Ireland and abroad. He is currently living in the West of Ireland.

“The design has as its background the crowds; men with soft caps and women in hats. The inclusion of women is important because, while most of the historic images depict mainly men on the streets at meetings, this was an event that had an enormous impact on whole families.

The coin depicts the bars of a gate and lock, with the crowd and Larkin in the background. The bars give the viewer the impression of looking through them, a motif that separates the scene from ourselves in the present where we have a myriad of hard won rights not only in labour law but in the Irish Constitution and in European law. The addition of the lock not only emphasises the hard stance taken by the employers of the day, it is also a pictorial reference to the centenary and its usual name, The Dublin Lockout.

In showing Larkin from behind we are facing the crowd of varying individuals, each with a story to tell. The emphasis is turned from Larkin as a focal point of the picture back to the community and their desperate situation at the time.”
